1. Call to Order * Roll Call * Pledge * Acknowledge Guests

Secretary Brocker called the Special Board Meeting of Gila County Community College District Governing Board to order at 11:00 a.m. on September 15, 2017. Secretary Brocker called roll and asked that the record show that all Board members were present except for President Spehar and Member White who were absent.

2. Call to the Public

Secretary Brocker asked that the record show there were no members of the public wishing to address the Board.

3. New Business

A. Vote to Consider Approval of the IGA with Gila County Pertaining to Economic Development and Preservation of Educational Facilities/Information/Discussion/Action

Secretary Brocker asked that Sr. Dean Cullen provide information for the Board. Sr. Dean Cullen stated that there were minor changes to the document. He informed that there were changes made to correct the names of the Regional Training Center and the Payson Campus. Chastity Van Buskirk provided information on a couple of typos. Sr. Dean Cullen informed that a section of the IGA outlines the payment dates that the County will submit funding to us at the rate of four payments of \$62,500 for a total of \$250,000. Funding from the County is to be used for the preservation of secondary education facilities. This funding is a continuation of the financial support the College receives from the County. Sr. Dean also informed of the termination clause in the document. Secretary Brocker asked if there were any questions and there was no response. She then asked for a motion.
